In which students irrespective of the caste and creed, are given scholarships of up to 50% of their tuition fees of all professional courses including Medical, Engineering, Dental etc., maximum up to rupees 6 Lacs (including Gov.t and Private Institutes). This MYSY became hugely popular in Gujarat.
